Let There Be Light! Series: Cosmic Christmas – Advent 2014 John 1:1-5

Genesis 1:3–5 (*NIV*) — 3 *And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.* 4 *God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness.* 5 *God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day.*

John 1:4–5 (NIV) — 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Darkness... the absence of light.

Genesis 1:1–2 (*NIV*) — 1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 Now the earth was formless and empty, *darkness was over the surface of the deep*, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

Isaiah 9:2 (NIV) — 2 *The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned.*

Christmas confronts us with the reality of Darkness.

Light...brings definition and direction

John 8:12 (NIV) — 12 When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (See also John 9:5; Psalm 18:28)

Christmas confirms Jesus as The source of Light for everyone.

Central Thought: The coming of Christ at Christmas reveals to us that the ultimate wisdom, the light of the universe is not a particle or a principle but a person, and thus, must be engaged relationally, not simply intellectually and analytically.

Christmas creates the opportunity for us to be Life Lights.

Matthew 5:14–16 (NIV) — 14 "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. 16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.
